

Who is Sebastian?

Our charity was developed from the vision of one very special nine-year-old boy who launched it just twelve days before he died of cancer in 2003.

Sebastian's aim was to provide a place where life-limited children and their families can holiday together away from the rigours of hospital appointments, gruelling treatment schedules and prying eyes.

Importantly for very sick children the home needed to be clean, safe and adaptable to meet their often complex physical and emotional needs. Sebastian's vision was simple, yet vital for those facing the loss of a beloved child; he wanted to create a private place where memories could be made which would last a life-time, even if that life was to be cruelly cut short.

What is Sebastian's Action Trust ?

In 2011 Sebastian's dream was finally realised and The Bluebells, the UK's first purpose built respite holiday home was completed.

The Bluebells is located in the beautiful village of North Waltham in Hampshire and now provides respite holiday breaks to over 300 families with seriously-ill children each year.

Our charity now also provides emotional and practical support to parents, siblings and grandparents affected by a beloved child's serious or life-limiting illness.



The Rules

1. Sebastian's Action Trust's 50:50 Club will be run on behalf of Sebastian's Action Trust a registered charity 1151146 and company limited by guarantee. 8339436. The Club is open to anyone aged over 16.

2. Subscription to the club shall be £5 per month, per membership, payable by standing order and each member will be allocated a permanent unique number for each £5 monthly subscription.

3. Individuals can have multiple subscriptions and there is no upper limit.

4. All members are eligible for inclusion in each monthly draw, so long as the subscription for that month has been paid at the time of the draw.

5. There shall only be one draw per month.

6. 50% of the monthly subscriptions will make up the prize fund, split as follows:

1st Prize 50% of prize fund

2nd prize 25% of Prize fund

3rd Prize 15% of prize fund

4th prize 10% of prize fund.

7. All prizes will be rounded down to the nearest pound Sebastian's Action Trust 50:50 Club Administrators will make all reasonable efforts to pay or post prizes within one week of the draw.

8. Winners will be posted on the Sebastian's Action Trust website and notified by email.

9. Email addresses will not be passed onto anyone without prior permission for the Club members.

10. Results of all draws will be binding and final and no correspondence will be entered into.
